NOTICE OF THE 71st ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING 2023

Notice is hereby given that the 71st Annual General Body Meeting of the Members of the Club will be held in the Club Hall from 10:30 AM on **Sunday, 18 June 2023**. Registration will start at 9:00 AM.

Members desirous of taking up the office of President, Vice President, Treasurer, Two Advisory Members, Ten Committee Members, One Permanent Catholic Member between the age of 18 & 30 years to be elected as "Youth Member" & One Catholic Lady who is a Permanent Member, to be elected as "Lady Member", One Permanent Catholic Member for "Permanent Finance Committee", One Permanent Catholic Member for "Permanent Catholic Member for "Permanent Information Technology" for the year 2023-24

The Nomination Forms can be obtained from the Office of the Secretary between 22nd May 2023 to 26th May 2023 on working days from 11:00 AM. to 2:00 PM and 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM and shall submit their Nomination Forms to the Secretary duly filled in, and duly proposed and seconded by two Permanent Members, on or before 8:00 PM on 26th May 2023. 
