# AGM 2023 report

The 71st AGM of the Club was held on Father's Day – Sunday, June 18th. The AGM was called to order at 10:43 am after the quorum had been reached.

A minute of silence was observed in memory of members who had passed away during the last year.

The outgoing president Ricky Patel first addressed the gathering. He was hanging up his gloves after a 4-year stint including the difficult time that was affected by covid.

The House unanimously passed the minutes of the last AGM, the Annual report & financial statements of the Club and the CC Orphan's trust for the year ended March 31, 2023; and the continuation of the present auditor Mr. A Balamuralikrishna.

Our Ecclesiastical advisor, Msgr S Jayanathan then addressed the members, urging them to support the managing committee and contribute to the growth of the Club. He also encouraged members to take part in social work and outreach programs.

The first business of the day involved several rule amendments that were proposed with the objective of better administering complaints by and against members in a fair, equitable, just and timely manner. These were discussed and unanimously accepted by the house.

The house then took up matters related to subscription and dues; management; and Committees (PoSH, Rule Book and Decorum). These too were discussed and unanimously passed by the house.

Proposals around different types of memberships (senior citizen, visitor, non-resident, senior dependents and temporary members) were then discussed and dealt with.

A few proposals related to change in management structure, advisory members, financial limitations, permanent finance committee were withdrawn by the president. The house agreed to the proposals of the Permanent Project Committee to replace the elevator in block A and the DG set.

The house then appointed 5 members to the Decorum Committee. Prakash Alvares was appointed as the Election Officer for the next election.

Jude Ferrao proposed the Vote of Thanks to the committee members, volunteers and staff for their commitment to the club, including to the outgoing and supporting committees for the work done during the year.





# CC Elections 2023-24

The Club members elected new office bearers and the managing committee for the year 2023-2024 on June 18th. This year we had 21 candidates standing for the 10 committee posts. With all the buzz around the elections a record 703 members registered for the AGM.

For the first time the Club used electronic voting systems to conduct the elections. 569 members found their way to the 8 booths and used the touchscreen systems to cast their votes in a quick and efficient manner. Marcus Pereira and a team of volunteers ably conducted the elections and quickly announced the results to a packed ballroom by early evening. Melville D'Souza was elected as the president. The following office bearers and committee members were chosen unopposed – Jude Lobo as the vice-president, Sunil Coutinho as the treasurer, Praveen Jerome and Mark Lushington as advisory members, Maya Bashyam as the lady member and Crystal Crasta as the youth member.

The 10 committee members elected were Lunita D'sa, Tushar Fernandes, Kenuite Martis, Joeita Pelegrim, Patrick D'Cunha, Rohan Pais, Gavin Cordeiro, Anup Saldanha, Marion D'Silva and Dianney Lobo.

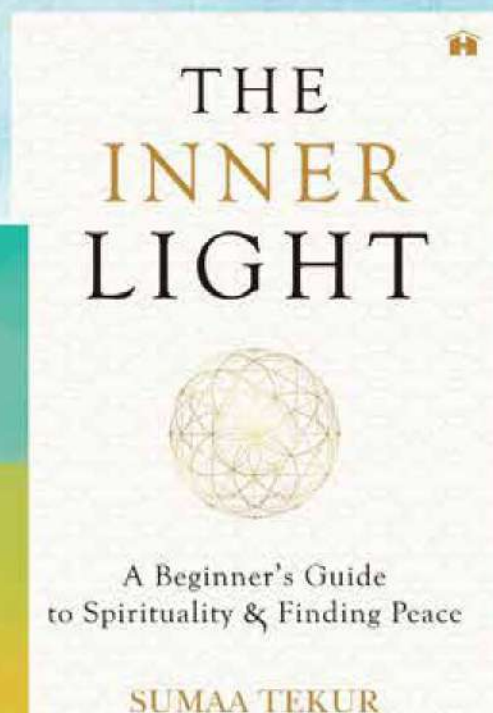
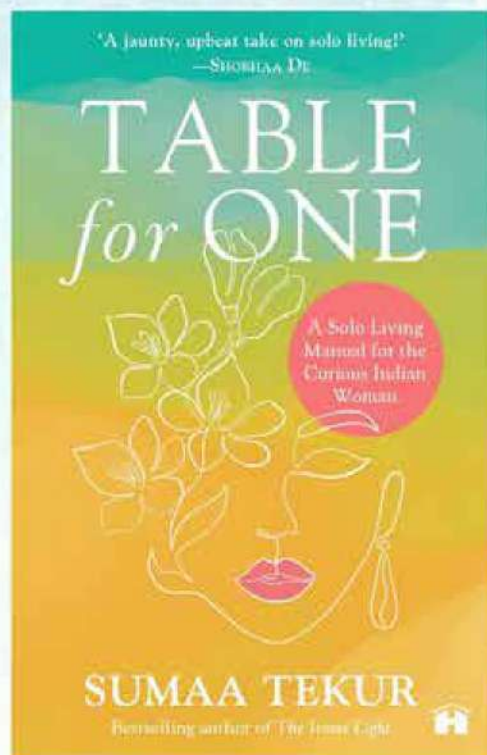

## **Change in Rules & New Rules which have come into effect from 19 Jun 2023**

### **4. TYPES OF MEMBERSHIPS**

Rule No. 4.3.1 (Amendment to the Rule reads as below)

Senior Citizen: Any person who has been a Permanent/Associate/Non-Resident Member of the Club for more than 10 years and is more than 60 years of age or above, shall be eligible to pay 50% of the subscription rate applicable to Permanent/Associate/Non-Resident Members

Rule No. 4.5 (Amendment to the Rule reads as below)

Visitor Member: A person may be admitted as a Visitor Member for a period not exceeding 30 days at a time on the recommendation of not less than 3 members of the Managing Committee. Visitor membership shall be granted for a period of 30 days at a time to families or single persons or students above 18 years of age who do not ordinarily reside in Bangalore, that is to say such persons should not be resident in Bangalore for more than 120 days in a calendar year. The subscription for such members shall be decided by the General Body from time to time. The Managing Committee, may at its discretion, extend the period of membership of the Visitor Member, provided that the total period of such visitor membership does not exceed 90 days in a calendar year.

Rule No. 4.18.1 (Amendment to the Rule reads as below)

Children of Associate members who are Senior Dependent Members shall be admitted as a "Sr. Dependent Member in Waiting" and shall get their full membership in order of the Waiting List, provided the Associate Member has been a member of the Club for five years or more.

### **6. COMPLAINTS AGAINST MEMBERS**

Rule No. 6.1 (Amendment to the Rule reads as below)

Complaints against Members

In the event of any complaint against any member, including MC Members, and General Body Appointed/Elected Committee Members in violation of the rules of the Club or conduct not conducive to the harmonious working of the Club, such complaint shall be addressed to the Secretary of the Club in writing. The Secretary shall then refer the said complaint to the Decorum Committee as specified in Rule 16. The secretary shall then refer the said complaint to the Decorum Committee with a copy to the Office Bearers.

Rule No. 6.1.3 (Amendment to the Rule reads as below)

The Managing Committee shall have the authority after considering the report and recommendations of the Decorum Committee (DC)/Enquiry Committee (EC) to Suspend, Debar or to Remove such member from the rolls of the Club if found guilty of misdemeanour, as advised by the DC/EC. If however the MC decides to differ or change the recommendation of the DC/EC, a detailed justification shall be presented to the DC/EC who may then concur with the change, or they may in their discretion decide to bring the matter to the General Body at the next AGM. The General Body will be the Final Authority in deciding the matter, as they are the Final Body of appeal for any member of the Club.

Rule No. 6.6 (Amendment to the Rule reads as below)

A member of the Catholic Club, who is the subject of an Enquiry which impinges on his Integrity and Probity and is being investigated by a Decorum Committee or a duly constituted Enquiry Committee, shall not be permitted to continue as a member of any Committee, or to stand for elections/re-elections to the same. Such membership shall be kept in abeyance and be formally decided upon by the Managing Committee on receipt of the recommendation of the said Enquiry Committee.

### **7. SUBSCRIPTION AND DUES**

Rule No. 7.11 (New Rule reads as below)

Temporary Members shall pay their third-year subscription for the full year in advance.

Rule No. 7.1.2

This Rule stands Deleted (concerning Luxury Tax)

Rule No. 7.1.5 (New Rule reads as below)

A member shall become a defaulter on the first day of July, October, January & April, if all subscription and other dues for the previous quarter are not paid. This will not apply to F&B Bills which have to be paid on the day of consumption, failing which the member will become a defaulter the next day.



## **9. MANAGEMENT**

Rule No.9.12 (Amendment to the Rule reads as below)

The President shall have overall control over the Managing Committee and may allot portfolios to each Member of the Managing Committee and put him/her in charge of such activity or department of the Club as he deems fit, such as Bar, Indoor and Outdoor Games, Billiards, Library, Cards, Membership, Sports etc.

However, any changes in portfolios during the term shall be decided by a majority vote at a Managing Committee Meeting with this change of portfolio being a specific agenda point.

## **10. DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE MANAGING COMMITTEE**

Rule No.10.3.3 (Amendment to the Rule reads as below)

Portfolios shall be handed over to the Members of the Managing Committee at the first MC meeting and such Members shall be in charge of the said portfolios and they shall have sub-committees and be responsible for all the activities coming under their respective portfolios.

Rule No. 10.6 (New Rule reads as below)

The Managing Committee shall form and appoint a Special Committee, PoSH (Prevention of Sexual Harassment) Committee, to investigate and redress all matters pertaining to complaints of Sexual Harassment according to the Law of the Land.

## **14.B RULE BOOK COMMITTEE (RBC)**

Rule No. 14.B.1 (New Rule reads as below)

The Rule Book Committee (RBC) shall consist of Three Members, two of whom shall be Ex-Office Bearers of the Club and One could be from the Legal profession. The recommended term for an RBC Member is 3 years. "However, this period can be extended if deemed necessary."

Rule No. 14.B.2 (New Rule reads as below)

The purpose of the RBC is for the following:

1. "To interpret the rules" if called upon to do so by the Managing Committee.
2. To draft or suggest amendments to the rules as may be deemed necessary from time to time, and to advise on amendments, additions and deletions as may be proposed by Members from time to time.

## **16 DECORUM COMMITTEE (DC)**

Rule No. 16.1 (Amendment to the Rule reads as below)

The DC shall comprise of five Permanent members who shall be appointed by the General Body at an Annual General Meeting. The Decorum Committee shall comprise of:

- a) Two members who are former Office Bearers
- b) Three members of Good Standing with professional experience in Adjudication, Counselling & Jurisprudence
- c) At Least One of the Five members shall be a Lady

Three members from the five shall conduct an Enquiry, and shall be selected by rotation.

All decisions of the DC shall be by majority vote.

Rule No. 16.1.1 (Amendment to the Rule reads as below)

The Decorum Committee (DC) shall investigate the complaint after giving an opportunity to the Member against who the complaint has been made to be heard. If the issue so warrants it, the DC may in its discretion address the matter. However, they may also decide to investigate the matter further, and they will get the necessary cooperation from the staff or the MC. If, however, they so decide, they may also refer the matter to a formal Enquiry Committee (EC) constituted specifically for this purpose. The responsibility for forming the said EC will rest with the MC in consultation with the DC.

Rule No. 16.2

This Rule stands Deleted (concerning appointment of DC Members)

Rule No. 16.3 (Amendment to the Rule reads as below)

The term of a Decorum Committee Member shall ordinarily be for Three years. Retirement of a DC Member shall be in rotation i.e., One-Two members retire every year and shall be eligible for re-appointment after a break of One year. Notwithstanding what is herein contained, if there are any pending matters before the DC, the same shall be completed prior to them demitting Office. If any vacancy arises during the year, the DC shall co-opt member/s who shall hold office until the next AGM



Rule No. 16.4

This Rule stands Deleted (concerning protocol for matters referred to the DC by the MC)

Rule No. 16.5

This Rule stands Deleted (concerning matters that can be referred to the DC)

Rule No. 16.6

This Rule stands Deleted (concerning powers of DC)

Rule No. 16.7 (Amendment to the Rule reads as below)

The decision of the DC shall be by majority vote.

Rule No. 16.8 (New Rule reads as below)

The DC has the following rights:

- 1.To inspect all Records, Interview Members and Staff, have access to all CCTV footage, etc.
- 2.The DC may also recommend that an Enquiry Committee be constituted by the MC to enquire into very serious disciplinary matters.

Rule No. 16.9 (New Rule reads as below)

All matters pertaining to enquiries shall be strictly confidential. The minutes of all meetings of the DC shall be recorded in a book maintained for that purpose and shall be signed by the Chairperson of the meeting or the subsequent meeting after being duly confirmed by the members who participated therein.

17. GENERAL BODY MEETINGS

Rule No. 17.1.1 (New Rule reads as below)

The notice of the Annual General Body Meeting shall be sent to Members at least 21 days before the date of AGM.

Rule No. 17.2.6 (Amendment to the Rule reads as below)

Elections & Appointments at the AGM:

- a) Appointment of Election Officer for the following year's AGM
- b) Appointment of Rule Book Committee (RBC)
- c) Appointment of Decorum Committee (DC)
- d) Election of the Permanent Committees (PFC, PPC, PITC)
- e) Election of the Managing Committee and Office Bearers

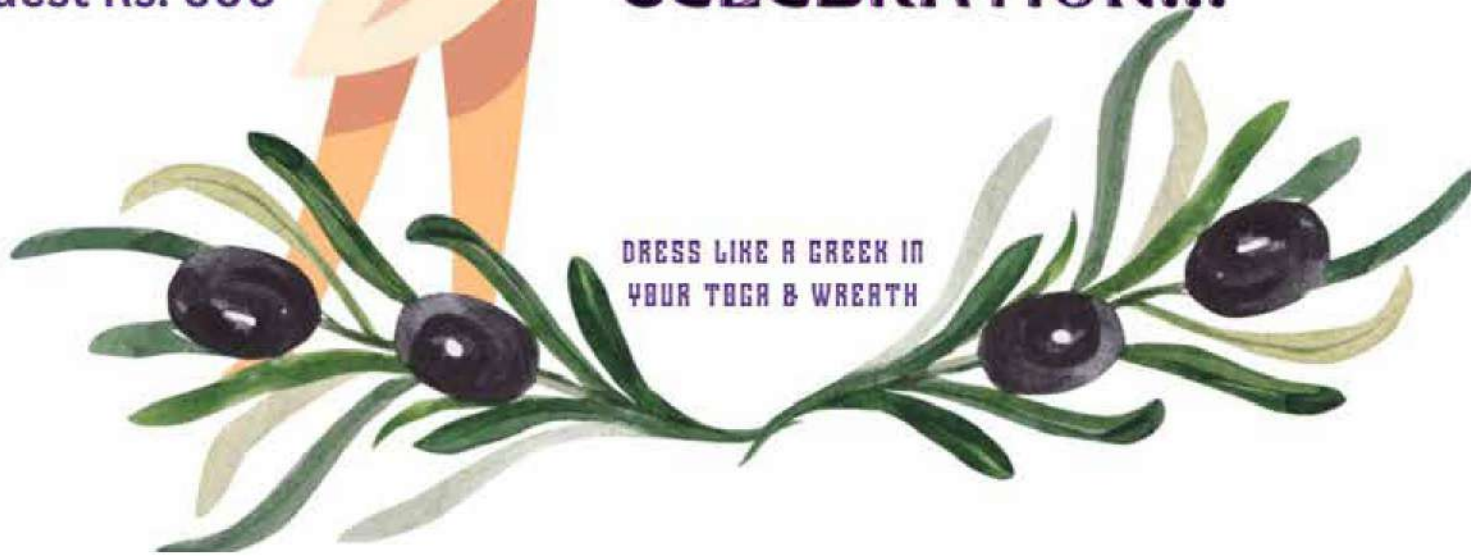
