
















ENTERTAINMENT

POMP HAS IT REALLY BEEN TEN YEARS?

I am trying to drive through our city's traffic clogged roads on the way to an afternoon meeting. My phone pings with a Whatsapp notification and I pick it up, since anyway the car is not at the moment anyway. It is a message from Nelson, requesting me if I can write something for ROMP's tenth anniversary. It does not take much time for me to reply, yes.

The traffic starts moving and I think, wow, is it really ten years since the ROMP began? Feels like almost yesterday, when I signed up for the first run along with my two younger children. We really were looking forward to the goodies being given, and we were not disappointed. In fact, we still have them today.

A rather late entrant to running, I had taken part in my first timed 10K event, a year prior. Ten years ago, running is not what it is today, it was not well known. People would think one was not normal to run on the roads. Today that is not the situation, running has become mainstream., and a regular part of the fitness regime of many people like me. Running helps me achieve balance in my life and also helps me with my writing as words and thoughts form and flow during the runs.

It is remarkable that the ROMP program, conceived ten years ago, has continued every month, without a break. It is arguably the longest running program of any Club in this city, and maybe even in the country.

Taking part in the first ROMP, the meticulous organisation, structured warm up by Suresh or Wayne, actual run route through the CBD - Central Business District, all of us wearing our ROM Tshirts/vests supervised by marshals enroute, cool down at end , followed by the mandatory group picture and sumptuous breakfast impressed me. This was better than many professional running events and without any cost to the members!

Over the years, this basic format has not changed. In other Clubs, there might be one running event conducted annually with much funfare, that is all. ROMP without any publicity has continued to sustain in a simple manner, month after month, year after year.

I know that I can land up on any Sunday morning (usually the third Sunday), and be accepted in to the ROMP run, 5 or 7 or even 10K one can run, as one wishes. One is always made to feel welcome no matter how long one has been away. That is what running does to you, there are periods in life when one can run injury free, and sometimes once cannot run when experiencing an injury.

When I go home, I look through the ROMP CC FB

page and it makes me nostalgic to see the pictures and videos over the years. Nine years ago, for the ROMP 1st anniversary, a picture shows me running with my two youngest children, one of who was just reaching my knees. Today, he is almost half a head taller than me. My children are busier with their studies and work so don't run with me anymore, but I treasure these moments with them that ROMP gave me.

I see so many regulars in the pictures and videos from the past ROMPs that keep coming for ROMP even today. A testament to the power of this program that draws them back regularly, as it has drawn me too.

Observing the ROMP over the past ten years, there is no doubt in my mind that without the silent and steady support of one man this would not have taken off and sustained. Take a bow Nelson! He has been supported by many over the years who believed in his vision for the program and worked tireless too: Tushar, Rezwan, Maya, Zachy and others.

My wish for ROMP for the next ten years is to flourish and continue, expanding beyond what it is today, to encouraging and training a ROMP team to take part in the two premier running events in our city held annually. Creating more awareness through regular talks by fitness experts (as we have had in the past). Knowledge of strength training, flexibility, hydration, nutrition, heart rate based running are important one keep one running well into mid age and beyond.

Recently at a residential spiritual retreat program I had attended off Sarjapur Road, I went for an early morning 10K run as I am in training for the upcoming Kaveri Trail marathon. One of the fellow retreat participants on coming to know this, asks me, Are you an athlete? This question makes me realise, how blessed I am, as a person who has been overweight all my life, to be able to run in events and place in the top percentiles of my age group, thanks to ROMP and the other running programs I have been part of. ROMP has certainly help me take care and maintain this physical body He has given me, by keeping me moving.

Thank you ROMP for all you have done for me in the past ten years. Look forward to the next ten!

PS: Though I have written these few lines from the perspective of a runner, ROMP encourages participants of all ages to join in, and walk or run, as one is comfortable. Do check it out, it will grow on you and set you on the path towards a healthier you! Looking forward to catching up at the ROMP tenth anniversary run!
