### Arts & Crafts (Painting Competition) - 20th July 2026

CCOT organized the Arts & Crafts (Painting) Competition on 20 July 2026, with enthusiastic participation from all nine homes. The competition received an excellent response, with over 60 paintings submitted by the children.

The competition featured five categories: Landscape, Floral, Beach, Origami, and Mandala. Art materials were procured by CCOT in June and distributed to all participating homes, providing the children with ample time to complete their artwork. The submission deadline was 15 July 2026.

The judging was held at the Catholic Club on 20 July 2026 at 6:00 p.m., where a panel of three judges carefully evaluated all the entries and selected a Winner and Runner-up in each category based on creativity, originality, and artistic merit.

As a special initiative, the winning and runner-up paintings will be professionally framed and presented as mementos to the Winners and Runners-up of the CCOT 17th Edition 2026 Golf Tournament, celebrating the children's artistic talents while creating meaningful keepsakes for the tournament's prize recipients.

The event was successfully organized and coordinated by Ms. Vinita Thamboochetty, whose dedicated efforts ensured the smooth execution of the competition and encouraged artistic expression and creativity among the children.

### From Toddlers to the Elderly: A Unique Initiative

This month, we reached out to beneficiaries across all age groups—from toddlers to the elderly—through two unique and meaningful initiatives.

Our first visit was to a children's home that houses around 40 children. Many of these children were in urgent need of essential hygiene supplies. We provided diapers for the young children, along with aprons and hair nets for the caregivers to promote better hygiene and care-giving practices.

In the same spirit, we also extended our support to an elderly care home that accommodates several old, sick, and bedridden residents. The home had an urgent requirement for adult diapers, which we were able to provide. In addition, we went a step further by supplying absorbent bed protection sheets (soak shield sheets). These waterproof sheets help protect mattresses and bed linen from frequent wetting or leakage, ensuring greater comfort, cleanliness, and dignity for the residents.

We also donated a sufficient quantity of essential medicines to help meet the residents' basic healthcare needs. These included commonly used medicines for everyday ailments such as fever, cold, cough, and other minor illnesses, enabling the caregivers to provide timely treatment and better care.

This initiative reflects our commitment to serving vulnerable individuals at every stage of life, ensuring that both the youngest and the oldest members of our community receive the care, comfort, and dignity they deserve.

### Furniture Donation

We were also privileged to have the support of a generous donor, a retired Colonel, who kindly donated some of his furniture as he was moving into a senior living facility. The donated furniture was distributed to Sneha Nilaya and Blessing Home, where it will provide comfort and serve the residents for years to come. This act of kindness is a wonderful example of how one person's generosity can make a lasting difference in the lives of others.
